

A graduate of Point Park University with a BFA in Musical Theatre and Acting, Ms. Metzger has built an extensive repertoire of stage, TV, film, and directing credits.

At the age of 15, she founded a musical theater showchoir, Musically Yours, which she led in over 500 performances at locations all over the United States. She has appeared on stages around the country including Los Angeles, Anaheim, CA, and Williamsburg, VA. She was also employed as a performer at the Magic Kingdom at Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida.

She founded Paragon Studios in 2004, and directs many of their shows, in addition to acting as level 4 and advanced adult instructor. She appears on stage occasionally. Fall Registration

Registration for fall classes will open mid-July. We offer training throughout the school year for ages 6-18, and six-week programs for ages 3-6.

Our adult training provides a six-week beginning acting course which runs three times a year in fall, late winter, and summer. Various classes in intermediate thru advanced acting, directing, and more are offered throughout the year.
